

THE WHEELS ON THE BUS

Teacher's Notes

Target Language

Vocabulary related to buses and actions.

Materials

Song Worksheet

Instructions

- 1** Give each child a copy of the song Worksheet. Introduce the words *bus, people, wheels, door, bell, wipes, horn, driver* by pointing to the pictures. Tell the children that they are going to sing a song about a bus.
- 2** Play the first verse of the song and do the actions with it, ie move your arms together round and round. Play it again and encourage the children to join in with you.
- 3** Do the same for verses 2-6. The action pictures on the song Worksheet will show you what you have to do. In verse 5 the children can join in with *Move along, please!* Play the song a couple of times until all the children have learnt the actions.
- 4** Play the song the whole way through and encourage the children to join in with the song and the actions. Repeat if desired.

Follow up

Arrange six chairs in a line, facing them the same way. The first is for the driver. Select six children to mime the song as the class sings.
